

## Learning Project WEEK 5– Disney and Marvel

### Year 5

This week we would like your child to select their own Disney/ Marvel films and characters as a basis for the activities set out here. As usual, there are some suggested activities for you to complete with your child or set your child to do over the coming week. The [blue underlined text](#) is a link, when clicked on, will take you directly to a website or to a resource which will help with the activity.

#### Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- [Times Table Rockstars](#). **At least 15 mins per day please.**
  - [Mathletics](#) – children should attempt this week's assigned activities.
- Arithmetic**
- Practice arithmetic for different areas of Maths using [Classroom Secrets Kids](#). Or children could find practical ways to practice e.g. adding different amounts of money or giving change.
- Problem Solving and reasoning**
- [White Rose](#)  
There are daily lessons being published on here, they include problem solving.

#### Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Children should read for at least **20 mins every day.**
- Following this, discuss the chapter/ section with your child and ask [questions](#).
- Complete the Friday Reading Activity on [BBC Bitesize](#).
- Focus on looking at comics on [Epic](#) – this is how the Marvel films started out.
- Remember to log onto Accelerated Reader after completing any book to see if you can take a test.

#### Weekly Spelling Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Encourage your child to practice the [Year 5/6 common exception words](#) (or their own list brought home from school).
- Ask your child to choose 5 Common Exception words. They can then write a synonym (word meaning the same), antonym (word meaning the opposite), find the meaning of the word and write an example of how to use it in a sentence.
- Use [Spelling Frame](#) to practice the Year 5 Spelling Rules – choose a rule that you know you struggle with.
- [Spelling Shed](#) – 20 mins

#### Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Create a comic strip story of your own. You could base it on your favourite Disney or Marvel character. Here is [a free template](#) you can use to help.
- Write a description of a Disney or Marvel character. Remember to include powerful adjectives and similes to describe them.
- Write a film review (there is a template on the [school website](#)) about your favourite Disney or Marvel film. We can share these with the class and give recommendations for half term watching!

### Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims for your child to choose their favourite films and stories and to be creative with the activities.

### **Time to Design**

Can you design a cape for a superhero? It could be a superhero that you have created or one from a story or film. Think carefully about the colours, symbols and materials you could use. If you can, make your cape and wear it for the Joe Wicks Workout on Friday, we would love to see the photos!

### **Draw with Disney**

Disney have a selection of videos on their website [Disney Magic Moments](#), where real-life artists and animators teach you how to draw step by step. The videos include animals, Disney characters and Marvel characters. Don't forget to share photos of them with teachers and on Twitter.

### **Blast from the past**

Do you know the history of the Legend of Thor? The true story of Mulan? What historical story The Lion King is based on? Many Disney and Marvel films are based on historical events and figures. Write a report or comparison on the history of your favourite Disney or Marvel character or film.

### **Around the world**

Can you design a world map showing your knowledge of the continents, countries and oceans? Then can you show on the map where your favourite Disney and Marvel characters are from!



### **Disney Drama**

Can you perform your favourite Disney or Marvel scene and create your own movie? Costumes are optional but encouraged! Feel free to video yourselves and email it to us so that we can watch your drama!

### **Discussion**

Discuss favourite films and characters with your family. Why do they like certain characters? What films did they watch when they were young? You could create interview questions, a quiz or you could create a graph to show most popular films and characters.
