



Year 4 Summer Term Curriculum letter.

Welcome back and we hope you had a fantastic break. This letter will detail what our class will be learning over the coming term!



In Maths, we will be developing our understanding of the four functions. We will be adding and subtracting four-digit numbers and multiplying and dividing 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, including solving 2-step problems. As well as this we will use our four functions to solve money problems, adding subtracting multiplying and dividing different amounts of money. Weekly maths papers will be completed, rotating between arithmetic and reasoning and frequent times tables practise will be completed as we approach our times tables test. Please encourage your children to regularly access TT Rockstars!

In English, we will be exploring poetry from image, using all of our amazing year 4 writing skills to create engaging and descriptive poetry. We will also become journalists in the classroom and create newspaper reports, describing events that have taken place. We will continue to work on our punctuation, handwriting and spellings as we complete our work.



In Science, we are learning about sound. We will discover and explore the ways in which it travels and how different materials can absorb sound. We will explore how instruments create vibrations and even create our own instrument!

This term in History we will be learning all about the Harlow new town, going back right to the Stone ages. We will learn about what a new town is and why they were created and discover more about Harlow's past, its origins and how things have changed throughout the years. By the end of the term our historians will be able to design their own new towns.



In PSHE we will be learning more about how to be healthy, both physically and mentally. We will be exploring ways in which we can help our friends feel happy and how we can treat ourselves as well as we possibly can.

In Art and Design and Technology we will be designing and creating wire sculptures. We will be exploring the works of Alexander Calder and Kendra Haste and will work on small-scale projects influenced by their works. In P.E we will be focusing on Archery and Net and Wall (badminton/tennis/volleyball).
