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Can You Apply for Free School Meals?

If your child is in Year R – Year 2 from September, they will continue to be entitled to universal free school meals meaning the Government pays for your child to have a school dinner every day. Children in Year 3 – Year 6 must apply for free school's meals. We are aware that many people's circumstances have changed over the last few months. If you think you may now be entitled to claim free school meals (because you are receiving universal credit) the office is able to conduct a quick online check for you before you apply. Please call Mrs Gant who will help to see if you are entitled. Even if you do not want your child to have a school dinner, the school receives additional funding for every eligible child.

Uniform

As we begin to prepare for the summer, just a few reminders about school uniform

- All children should be in school uniform with black shoes
- Children's PE top needs to be the house colour of the house they are in
- Children must have a change of footwear for PE
- Jewellery is not allowed in school, earrings should only be studs and children must be able to take them out themselves
- All our uniform can be purchased from Create Identitee
