Welcome back and we hope you had a fantastic break. This letter will detail what our class will be learning over the coming term!




In Maths, we will be developing our understanding of the four functions. We will be adding and subtracting four-digit numbers and multiplying and dividing 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, including solving 2-step problems. We will be looking at angles, shapes, and negative numbers. We will continue to look at telling and working with time in 12- and 24-hour clock. Regular maths papers will be completed to develop our arithmetic and reasoning. Frequent times tables practice

will be completed as we approach our multiplication check this term. Please encourage your children to regularly access TT Rockstars!

In English, we will be exploring portal stories like Alice in Wonderland and then we will write our own portal story. Using all our amazing year 4 writing skills, we will create engaging and descriptive poetry. We will also become journalists in the classroom and create newspaper reports, describing events that have taken place. We will continue to work on our punctuation, handwriting and spellings as we



continue to work on our punctuation, handwriting and spellings as we complete our work. Our Guided Reading text this term will be How to Train Your Dragon!



In Science, we are learning about sound. We will discover and explore the ways in which it travels and how different materials can absorb sound. We will explore how instruments create vibrations and even create our own instrument!

This term in History we will be learning all about the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. We will explore what life was like in Anglo-Saxon Britain and how did that change because of the Viking invasion.



In PSHE we will looking at our My
Happy Minds Unit-Engage. This unit
looks at goal setting and how we
can use the skills we have already learned!



In Art and Design and Technology we will be designing and creating wire sculptures. We will be exploring the works of Alexander Calder and Kendra Haste and will work on small-scale projects influenced by their works. In R.E. Mrs Jones will be exploring Judaism and Christianity with the children.
